An insurance binder naming the City of Bath as a co-insured is attached will be provided prior to commencing operation.

Performance Standards:

No more than 40% of the depth of the sidewalk will be used for vending/display, and there will be a clear path of at least 4' wide for pedestrians to use the sidewalk. The vending cart/stand will not block access to or egress from any doorway, driveway/access point, or piece of emergency equipment. Use of the sidewalk will not block vehicular or pedestrian sight distance so as to create a hazard.

The applicant must provide liability insurance naming the City of Bath as a co-insured to cover use of the sidewalk. The applicant agrees to keep the insurance in force while the sidewalk vending activity takes place. At least 30 days notice will be provided to the Codes Enforcement Officer of cancellation of insurance applicable to sidewalk vending activities.

Vending will take place between 6 AM and 10:30 PM. The cart or stand will take no longer than 30 minutes to set up and take down, and will be removed by 11 PM. All products being sold will be stored/displayed on the cart except drinks, which can be

in a separate container or containers.

Vendors will not verbally solicit business.

See the Sidewalk Vending Ordinance for additional details. It's available on the City's website, in the Business Ordinance section of The City Clerk's page of the website, and/or from the Codes Enforcement Office.
