Bath Riverwalk Extension, Neighborhood Meeting

August 8, 2024

Jared Winchenbach from Gorrill Palmer presented on the meeting agenda, purpose, and intent, stating that there would be time for questions after the presentation, and to review the large-scale concepts displayed at the front of the room.

Jared presented on the scope of the proposed extension, the feasibility study process, and current timeline.

A number of residents expressed concerns about the impacts of potential riverwalk users from a safety, or noise perspective.

Questions were asked about the reasoning behind the project and the meeting.

There were statements and questions about invasive and endangered species.

There was a question about the intended seasonal use of the walkway.

There were questions about potential flooding and sea level rise incompatibility and planning.

There were concerns about the impacts of construction, including large equipment.

The public discussion portion broke up into smaller groups for discussion at approximately 7PM.
