Concept: Richardson & Associates worked with the City of Bath – and a complex array of neighborhood, recreational, environmental, downtown business, and private property owner stakeholders – to plan, design, and establish a new Downtown Waterfront Pathway along the banks of the Kennebec River. 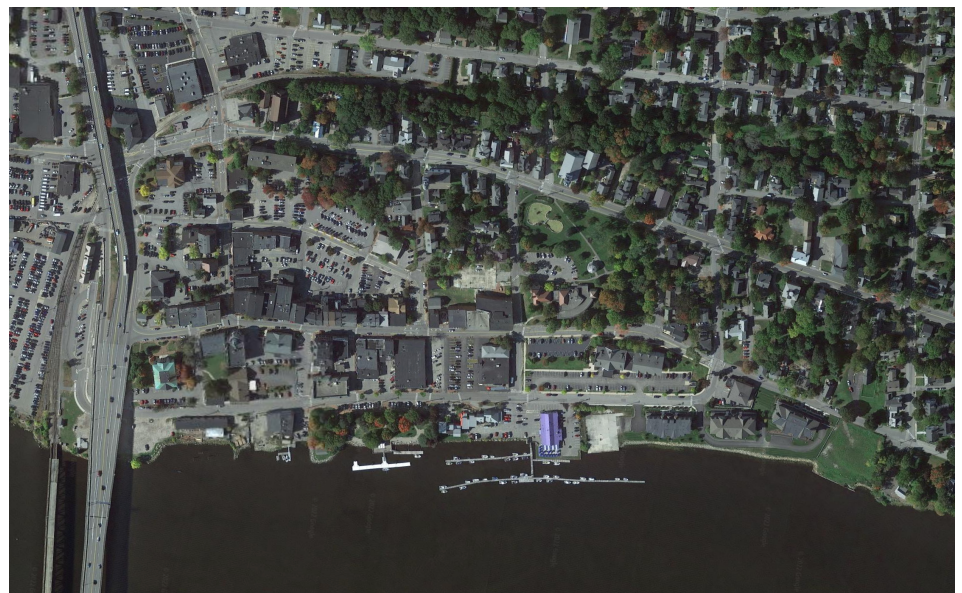
